Wat is een Global Grant ?

YOUR PROJECT MUST:

- Have a long-term, sustainable impact
- Include activities that align with the goals of one of Rotary's areas of focus
- Have a minimum budget of \$30,000 (which includes a minimum World Fund match of \$15,000)
- Address an important need identified by the community
- Strengthen the community's capacity to address its own needs



YOU MUST:


- Qualify your club or district for global grants every year
- Actively involve the benefiting community in the project
- Partner with a club in another country
- Act as primary sponsor of no more than 10 active global grants at a time
- Develop a project plan that includes a budget and a financial management plan
- Apply for a grant through My Rotary
- Stay up-to-date in reporting for all active grants

For humanitarian projects and those that involve vocational training teams:


- Conduct a community assessment before applying and include the results in your application
- Measure progress toward the outcome

Global grants

Global grants support large international activities with sustainable, measurable outcomes in Rotary's areas of focus. By working together to respond to real community needs, clubs and districts strengthen their global partnerships.

Read [A Guide to Global Grants](#) for detailed information on planning your project, applying for a grant to fund it, carrying it out, and reporting on your progress and outcome.

What global grants support

Global grants can fund:

- Humanitarian projects
- Scholarships for graduate-level academic studies
- Vocational training teams, which are groups of professionals who travel abroad either to teach local professionals about their field or to learn more about it themselves

How they're funded

The minimum budget for a global grant project is \$30,000. The Foundation's World Fund provides a minimum of \$15,000 and maximum of \$400,000. Clubs and districts contribute District Designated Funds (DDF) and/or cash contributions that the World Fund matches. DDF is matched 100 percent and cash is matched at 50 percent. Global grants can also be funded with endowed earnings and directed gifts.

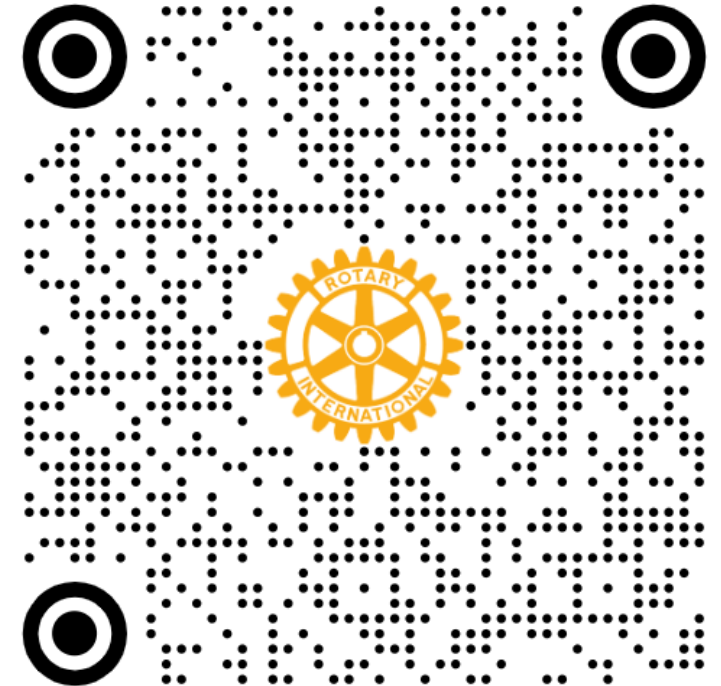

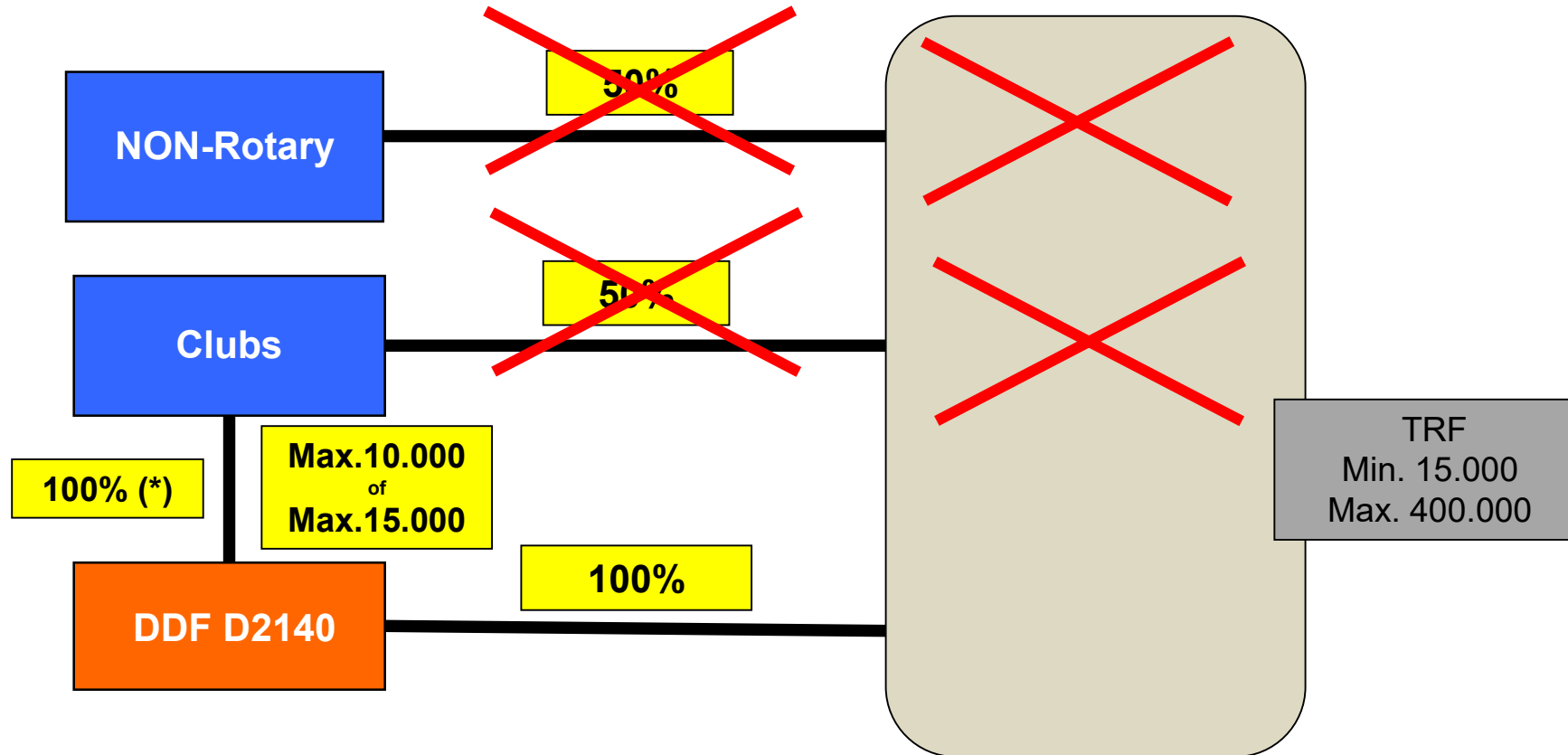
Boodschap van 28 mei:

Because of this, the Trustees of The Rotary Foundation have decided that World Fund resources will be used to match only District Designated Fund (DDF) contributions. This match will remain at 100 percent. The match on cash contributions to grants will be eliminated, effective 1 July 2020.

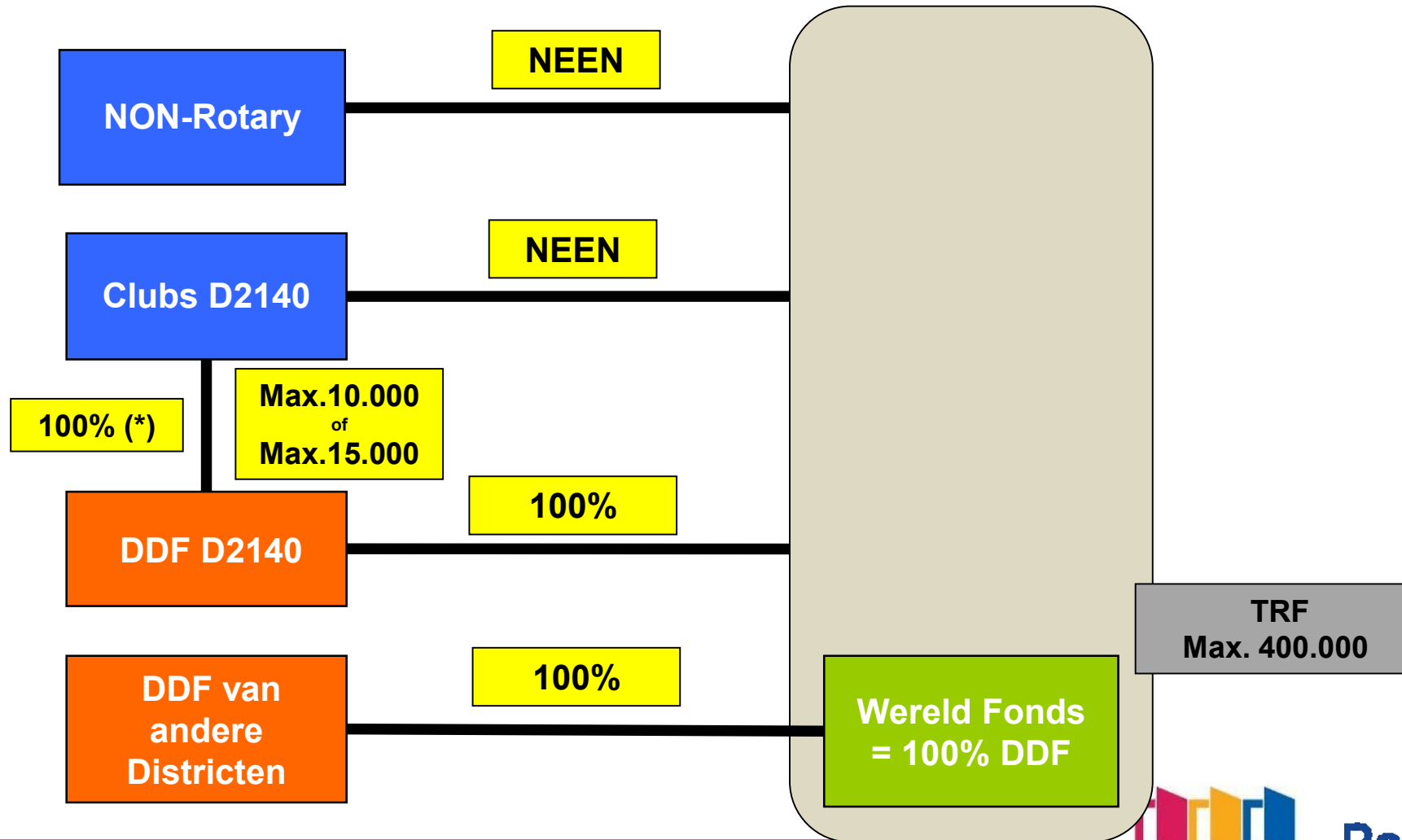
Global grant applications that have been submitted but not yet approved on 1 July will still receive the World Fund match for cash contributions.

- ✓ *Een goede voorbereiding*
- ✓ *Een goed uitvoeringsplan*
- ✓ *Een operationele en financiële controle*

Enkele voorbeelden van wat niet is toegelaten

- Aanschaf van enkel medisch materiaal
- Eco-stoves
- Hygiëne training die niet focust op gedragsverandering
- Een project dat enkel in water en sanitation systemen voorziet
- Louter medische en chirurgische missies, zonder “capacity-building” (tenzij levensbedreigend of aangeboren aandoeningen)
- Aanschaf van louter educatief materiaal,
- Financiering van salarissen of schoolbenodigdheden, zonder verantwoording dat de gemeenschap daar achteraf zelf in kan voorzien.
- Voedselprogramma's voor scholen
- Een basiseducatie- en alfabetiseringsproject zonder trainingsplan voor de leraars (oa. over nieuwe lestechnieken)

Sponsors

- Een rotaryclub of een district in het land waar het project zal doorgaan (in or near the community)
= the primary host sponsor
- Een rotaryclub of district van buiten het land waar het project zal doorgaan
=the primary international sponsor





Host sponsor

- Initiates the project
- Conducts a community assessment
- Manages project implementation and budget
- Provides local assistance and support to vocational training teams and scholars during their time abroad
- Receives project funds



International sponsor

- Provides financial assistance, technical support, and other guidance
- Performs project tasks that can be done remotely, as well as participating in service during site visits
- Prepares any vocational training teams or scholars for travel and study abroad



Both sponsors

- Must be qualified to participate in a global grant
- Develop a project plan
- Have project committees that collaborate with each other
- Partner with a cooperating organization (a nongovernmental organization, community group, or government entity) if needed
- Submit project reports in the Grant Center

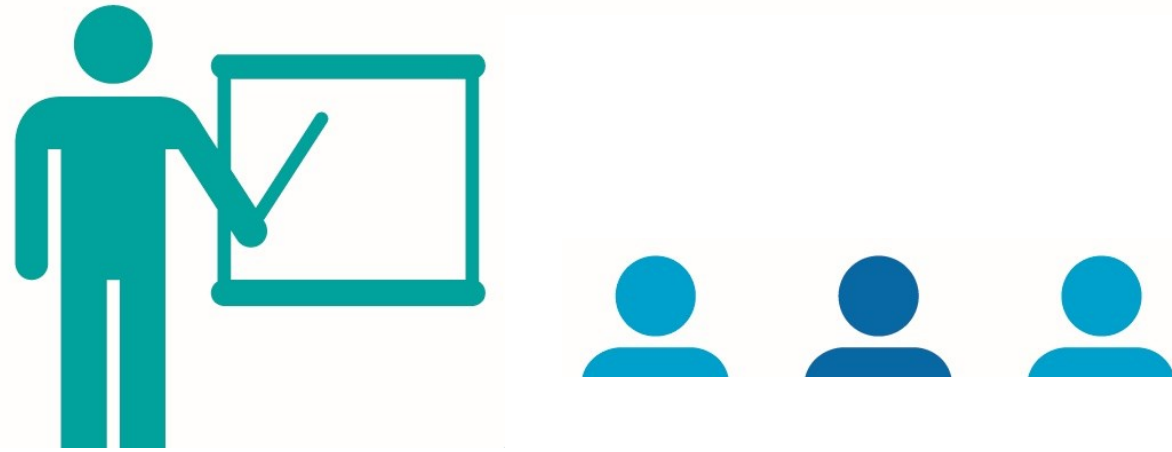

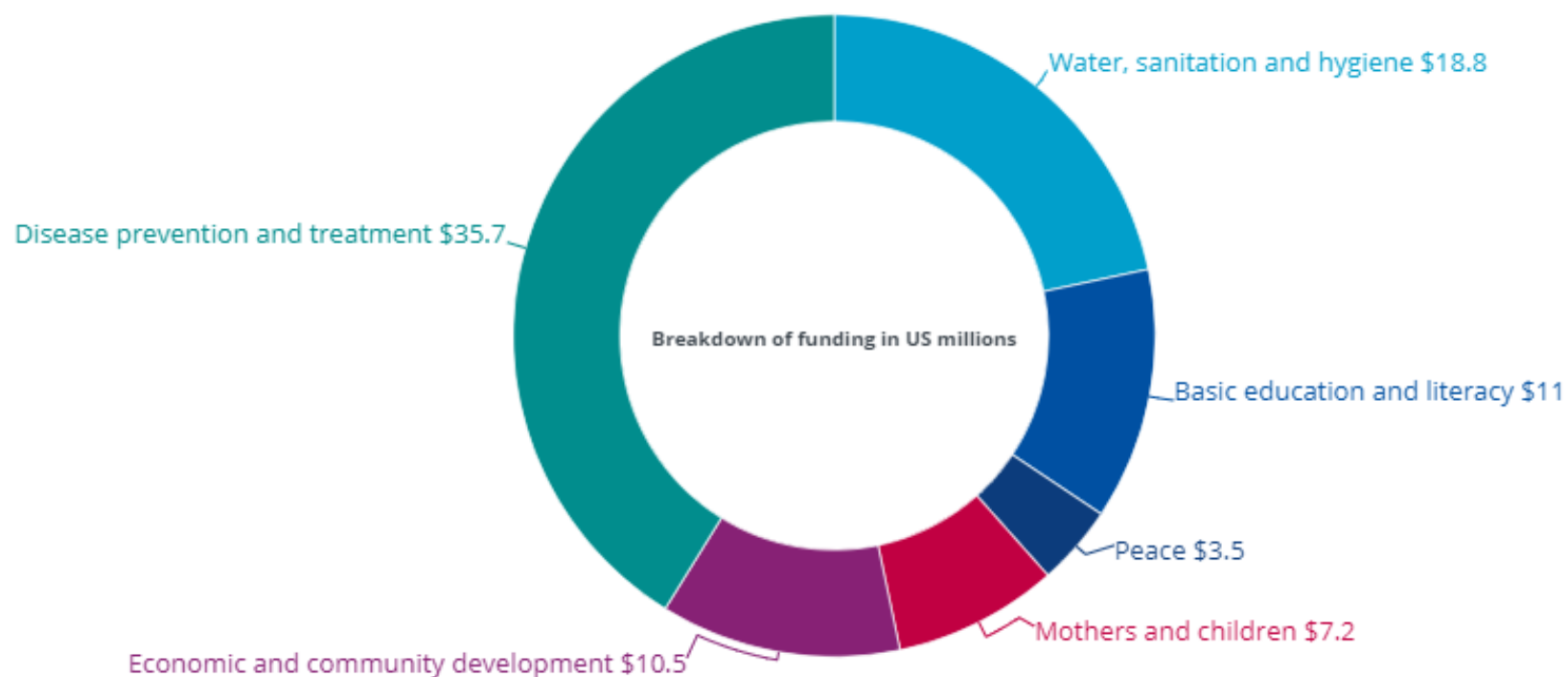

1. Clean water , sanitation and hygiene education (WASH programs)

Wanneer mensen toegang hebben tot zuiver water , daalt de prevalentie van ziektes , kinderen zijn gezonder en lopen gemakkelijker school en hebben moeders meer tijd voor hun gezin omdat ze niet dagelijks moeten op zoek gaan naar water.

HOE ?

- Zorgen voor toegang , opslag en bescherming zuiver (drink)water
- Investering in infrastructuur en ondersteuning regionale , nationale autoriteiten (bv. oprichten toiletten, zuiver water op school , ...) met betrokkenheid Rotariers
- Uitwerking trainingsprogramma voor onderhoud waterinstallaties...





DISEASE PREVENTION AND TREATMENT

2. Disease prevention and management

- fysische ziekten (kanker , diabetes , alzheimer ...)
- mentale ziekten (verslaving , zelfmoord , depressie ...)

HOE ?

- * toegang en uitbreiding medische dienstverlening (bv. revalidatie na trauma , hulpprogramma Alzheimer , ..)
- * medische uitrusting (cave geen ziekenhuis (nieuw)bouw , cave mobile health care , cave niet-medisch materiaal)
 - = verbouwing enkel bij vooraf bewoond/gebruik en noodzakelijk voor project
 - = geen ambulance , tenzij uitbreiding zorg naar verafgelegen gebieden of zeer specifiek bv. preventieve bloedafname. Geen urgenties
 - = geen zonnepanelen
 - = geen exclusief meubilair
 - = best nieuw , lokaal aangekocht en lokale opleiding gebruik en onderhoud
- * training en opleiding lokaal gezondheidspersoneel (cave geen team missions zonder locale input)





MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH

1. Clean water, sanitation and hygiene education

3 . Maternal Health and Child disease

- reduceren mortaliteit pasgeborenen en kinderen jonger dan 5 jaar
- verbeteren gezondheid moeder voor, tijdens en na de bevalling
- vaccinaties (niet uitsluitend polio) , preventie / behandeling SOA's

HOE ?

- * toegang en uitbreiding medische dienstverlening
- * medische uitrusting (cave geen nutritie programma's pasgeborenen , geen speeltuigen , speelpleinen)
- * training en opleiding gezondheidspersoneel : hoe vaccineren ? Borstvoeding ? Ziekte preventie van de pasgeboren baby door de moeder , ...

Basic Education and Literacy

Wat kan?

- Verhogen van het niveau van scholing op alle niveaus, in samenwerking met de lokale school en lokale autoriteiten
- Volwassenenonderwijs ondersteunen
- Curriculumontwikkeling in al haar facetten
- Leerlingen met een beperking specifiek onderwijs aanbieden

Basic Education and Literacy

Wat kan niet?

- Aankoop van infrastructuur, voertuigen, hardware zelfs met training over het gebruik ervan
- Salarissen van lesgevers, lesgelden van leerlingen, schoolmaterialen zonder garantie op duurzaamheid
- Projecten die inzetten op extracurriculaire activiteiten
- Voedselvoorziening op school, inclusief installaties om hierin te voorzien
- Opleiding van één generatie leerlingen

- Adopt-a-village
- Verdelen van humanitaire hulpgoederen



Community economic development

Wat is mogelijk?

- Klimaatgerelateerde projecten:
 - Hernieuwbare energie
 - Beheer natuurlijke hulpbronnen
 - Klimaatsverandering en natuurrampen

Projecten zijn sterk wanneer de lokale samenleving er in slaagt hun economische ontwikkeling zelfstandig verder te zetten wanneer de Rotariërs zich terugtrekken uit het project.

Global Grant: Financieel beheer

- *Een aparte Grant rekening verplicht*
- *Verplicht twee handtekeninghouders*
- *Bankkosten internationale betalingen*
- *Vermijd CASH-transacties (opvolging).*
- *Originele facturen bijhouden voor alle uitgaven boven de 75 \$,*
- *Geef elk document/factuur een volgnummer dat gebruikt wordt bij de betaling.*
- *Lees de voorwaarden in de MOU (certificatie)*



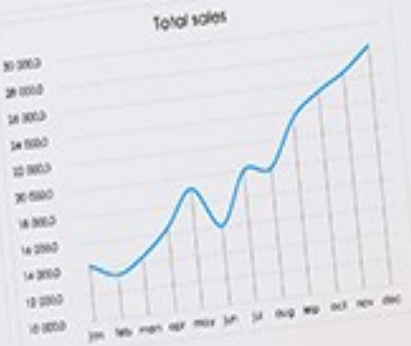
Global Grant kosten:

- *TRF rekent 5% kosten aan op alle cash-inbreng die via TRF loopt voor Grants (oa. voor bankkosten voor internationale transfers)*
- *Dit kan vermeden worden door rechtstreeks op de projectrekening te storten, maar dan zijn er geen Credits voor PHF en draagt u zelf de internationale bankkosten. Enkel interessant bij een groot koersverschil tussen Rotary dollar en officiële koers.*

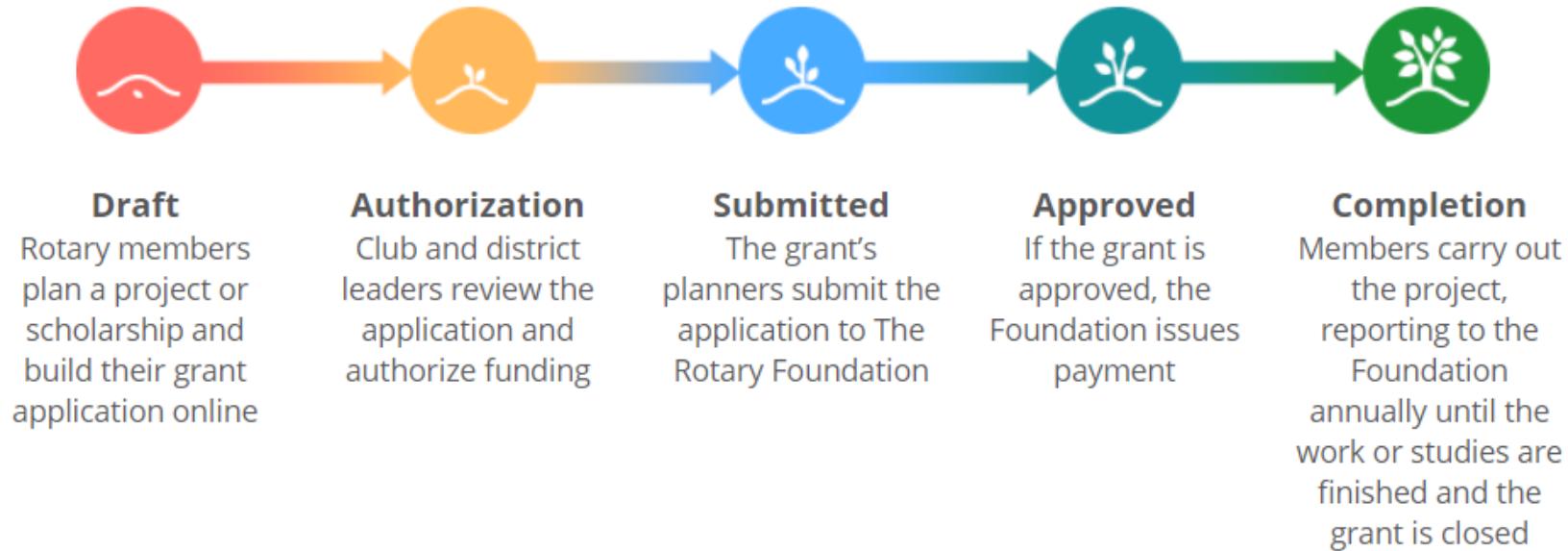




